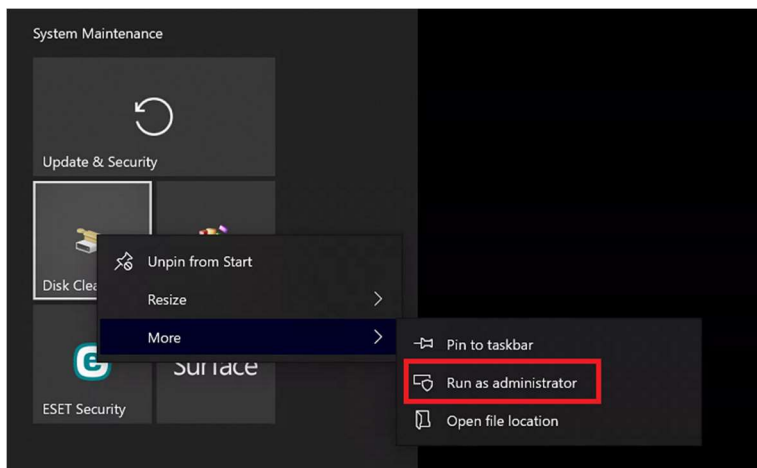
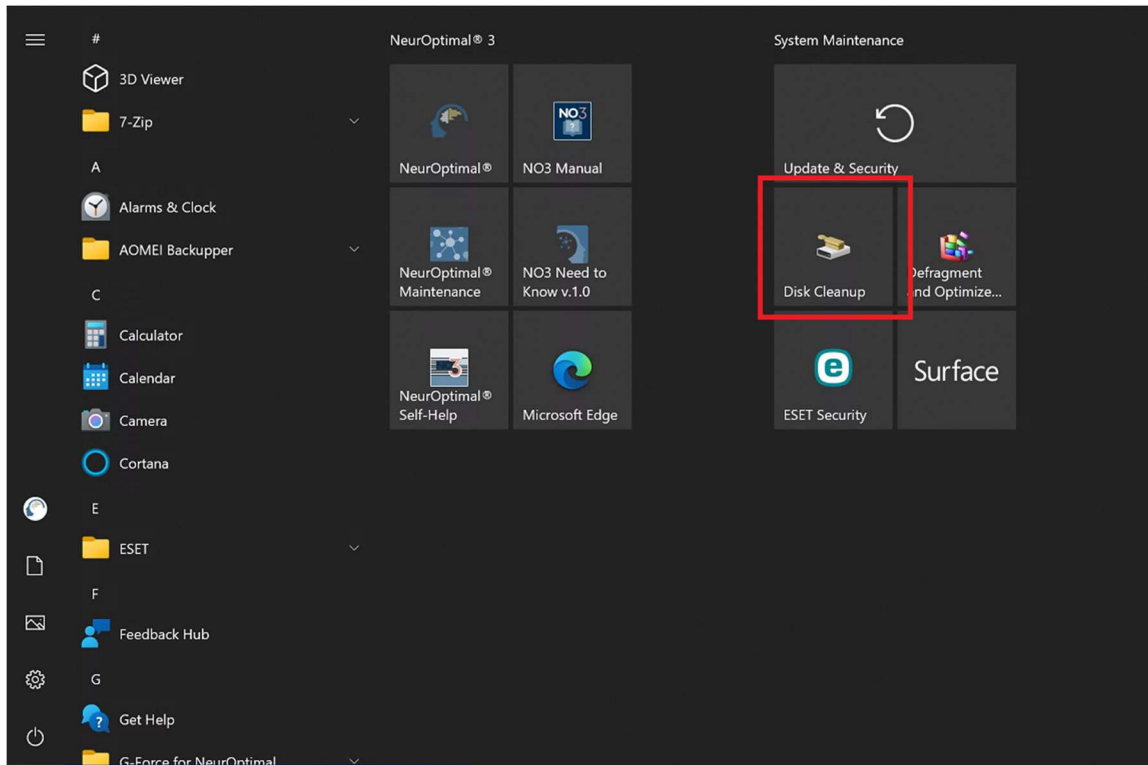
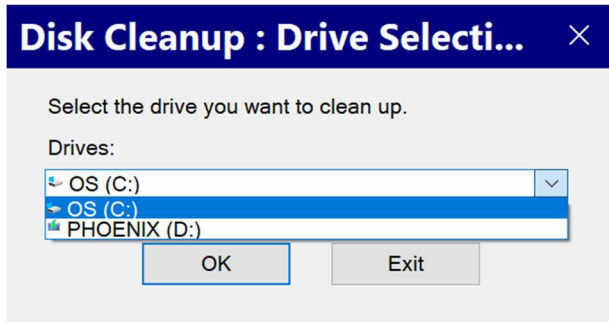


Disk Cleanup Guide

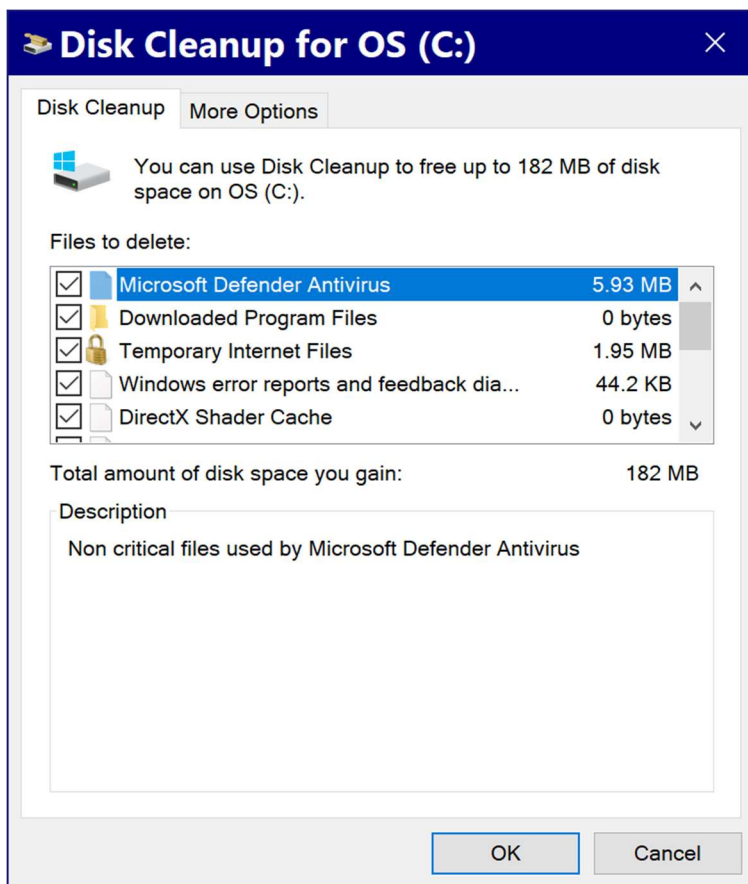
Open the Start Panel. Right click Disk Cleanup and run it as as administrator.
