Select the **Playback** tab and verify **Speakers** are set as **Default Device**.



- a. In the same **Sound** window, select the **Recording** tab.
- b. Right-click Stereo Out and select Properties.
- c. In the next window, select the *Listen* tab.
- d. Check *Listen to this device*.
- e. Use the drop-down menu and set it to **Default Playback Device**.
- f. Press **OK** on both windows.
